

CODE OF CONDUCT

For all students, parents and guardians at Studio 79 Youth!

The aim of Studio 79 Youth is to make sure that all students experience dance in a positive, fun and safe environment. For this to be achievable please take note of the following rules and regulations. This is important and will assure the wellbeing of all students that attend our youth group.

If any student is unable or not willing to comply with these rules and regulations they may be asked to leave and withdraw from the school, with a notice period. As parents and guardians we encourage that your child is to learn the following guidelines for the school and comply with them.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Punctuality

It is important that all students arrive for class on time. If you are going to be late can you please inform the Teacher. If a student is late for class they may miss important information. It will also distract other students from their learning. This could also put students at risk of an injury if they miss the warm up.

Attendance

Attendance is important within our school. If a student does not attend regularly then the students development is affected. All exam/festival/crew students attendance will be monitored and those who fail to be committed may be withdrawn from the school.

Discipline

When attending Studio 79 Youth, students are expected to behave in a respectful and well-mannered way. Students should respect both their Teachers and other dancers in class and out of class, failure to do this may result in your child being asked to leave. Parents/Guardians are not allowed in the studios while classes are taking place and can wait in the designated seating areas.

Parents/Guardians should not have any interaction with another child unless given permission by Studio 79 Youth or the Parent/Guardian of the child themselves.

It is important that parents/guardians discourage any inappropriate behaviour from their child to any member of staff, other students or parents, and they should help their child to recognise positive and good behaviour.

Please be realistic with your child's ability and do not set expectations too high, if they do not achieve your expectations it may damage their confidence and passion.

Each student is different and may have different goals, therefore should get praised individually, and not compared to other students.

Parents/Guardians must uphold any decisions/recommendations made by the Teacher.

All parents/Guardians should support their child in class expectations.

No-one is to post on any social media about students, parents, teachers or Studio 79 youth in a negative way.

Unacceptable behaviour from any parent/guardian or any other family member will not be tolerated, and may result in being banned from the premises/events/performances or even Studio 79 altogether. Unacceptable behaviour includes bullying, swearing, spitting, fighting, any uncomplimentary comments towards others and all other serious offences.

When at any events/competitions/exams you are representing our school and we expect that parents/guardians/students act in a respectful and appropriate manner. As parents/guardians we encourage you to support all students and our school. If any issues arise please can you contact Laura and it will be dealt with appropriately.

Uniform/Changing

It is important that students come to classes in the correct uniform this is to ensure students work safe and correctly in a neat and presentable way. If students need to change we have facilities for this, and should not be alone with one adult at any time.

Personal Property

Students should keep all their valuable items with them at all times as we can not be responsible if they go missing.

Fees

All payments should be made by the date on the invoice, failure to do so may result in a surcharge or even withdrawal.
